Stevens Creek Trail Update



The City is in the process of completing the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the final section of the Stevens Creek Trail in Mountain View. Reach 4, Segment 2 will be 1.7 miles long and run from Yuba Drive to Mountain View High School, crossing both El Camino Real and Highway 85.

Stevens Creek Trail is a bike and pedestrian trail that connects many of the City's parks and neighborhoods. The Trail is used by more than 1,000 people each day for recreation and commuting. Currently, trail users can travel from Shoreline at Mountain View Park along the Trail to the El Camino Real area.

Based on the comments that were received after the draft EIR was released last year, potential revisions were developed to the proposed alignment of the Trail. This fall, staff will meet with permitting agencies, organizations and the public to review the potential revisions. A final EIR is expected by the end of this year and will be reviewed by the Parks and Recreation Commission. The final EIR is expected to go to the City Council for final action in early 2004.
