

# Stevens Creek Trail Update

The City Council approved the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for Stevens Creek Trail, Reach 4 Segment 2 in June. The 1.7-mile long segment of the Trail runs from Yuba Drive to Mountain View High School and will be the final portion of the bike and pedestrian trail in Mountain View.

The Final EIR included responses to all of the individuals, organizations and public agencies that commented on the Draft EIR. Revisions were made to the project to reduce impacts on the habitat in the Stevens Creek corridor.

The Capital Improvement Program adopted for the current fiscal year provides most of the funds to pay for the next section of the Trail that will begin at the existing trailhead at Yuba Drive and end at a pedestrian tunnel under El Camino Real on the south side of the roadway. The project received \$700,000 in grant funds from the State Transportation Fund for Clean Air.

Preliminary design of this next section of Trail will begin shortly. The remainder of the Trail, from El Camino Real to Mountain View High School, is not yet funded.
