

# Stevens Creek Trail Update

The City is in the process of completing the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the final section of the Stevens Creek Trail in Mountain View. Reach 4, Segment 2 will be 1.7 miles long and run from Yuba Drive to Mountain View High School.



Stevens Creek Trail is a bike and pedestrian trail that connects many of the City's park, recreation and open space facilities. It is used by more than 1,000 people each day for recreation and commuting. Currently, trail users can travel from Shoreline at Mountain View Park along San Francisco Bay to the El Camino Real area. This final section will extend the trail to Mountain View High School.

The Draft EIR for Reach 4, Segment 2 was released in July, 2002. Since that time, plans for the final section of the Trail have been reviewed and revised several times based on suggestions and comments from permitting agencies, organizations and members of the public. A final EIR for the project should be complete this spring, when it will be submitted to the City Council for final certification.
