Stevens Creek Trail Receives Two More Grant Awards

The City of Mountain View has been awarded two grants totaling more than \$1 million to assist in the funding of the final phase of the Stevens Creek Trail, running from El Camino Real to the Sleeper Avenue area. The two grants represent more than 75 percent of the \$1.5 million estimated cost to complete that section of the Trail.

The Stevens Creek Trail is a bike and pedestrian path that runs along Stevens Creek in Mountain View and is part of a larger network of trails throughout the Bay Area. When finished, the Trail in Mountain View will stretch from Mountain View High School to the Bay.

This summer, the City was awarded an \$874,000 California Rivers Parkway Grant by the State Resources Agency for the Trail. The City also recently received a \$275,000 Transportation Fund for Clean Air Program Grant from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District for the project.

The City began designing the final phase of the Trail project this fall and construction is expected to begin in late 2007 or early 2008.
