



Stevens Creek Trail Update

Work on the Stevens Creek Trail extension from El Camino Real to Sleeper Avenue is in the final phase of construction and is expected to be complete in April. This section of the project will include a paved trail lined with native shrubs, a grove of oak trees, a meadow area, and a steel bridge over Stevens Creek. The project will open easy access to the Stevens Creek Trail for residential neighborhoods south of El Camino Real.

The next segment of the trail includes a bicycle/pedestrian bridge over Highway 85 and then continues to a landing area at the intersection of Dale Avenue and Heatherstone Way. This segment is currently in the early stages of the design phase and is undergoing technical review by Caltrans—this section is not currently funded. The design of the final proposed trail section from Dale Avenue and Heatherstone Way to Mountain View High School is unscheduled.

When completed, the hiking and biking trail will run from Shoreline at Mountain View Park to Mountain View High School. For more information on the Stevens Creek Trail project, call the Public Works Department at (650) 903-6311.
